6	January 2022	Discussions of students with parents/ teachers/ principal regarding freedom fighters
7	February 2022	Role play of freedom fighters

B. Activity in Class or School Assembly under theme "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" (Class VI-XII)

SN	Month	Suggested Activities
1	August 2021	During the class or school assembly, one boy and one girl student shall participate/ present on the theme " <i>Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav</i> " for around 2 minutes each.
2	September 2021	Poster making competition regarding freedom fighters
3	October 2021	Paragraph writing about places related to freedom struggle
4	November 2021	Speech/ dialogue, discussion, popular story/ poem recitation about freedom fighters
5	December 2021	Role play of freedom fighters
6	January 2022	Discussions of students with parents/ teachers/ principal regarding freedom fighters
7	February 2022	Quiz on freedom fighters or places/ events related to freedom struggle
8	March 2022	Historical verbatim/ patriotic songs during the online/ offline class/ school assemblies on freedom struggle or freedom fighters
9	April 2022	Discussions by teachers in class to make children aware about how a nation is build
10	May 2022	Lectures by Principal/ Teachers about freedom struggle
11	June 2022	Activities around India's freedom struggle events, people & places
12	July 2022	Group discussions of students regarding freedom fighters and freedom struggle events/ places
13	August 2022	Declamation contest regarding historical events/ incidents/ places during India's freedom struggle movement
